General Sign Information:

- This sign would be identical to the existing sign at Castleton Square Mall.
- There would not be any animation.
- Only the west face would change, they would be willing to stipulate to that.
- It would be on Duke property.
- Anticipated to cycle every 12-15 seconds.
- Digital sign.

Public Benefit:

- Will advertise all Amber Alerts.
- Will work with emergency personnel and Indiana Dept of Homeland Security to advertise emergencies.
- Lamar uses landscapers to sculpt the trees. Lamar is currently contemplating changing the landscaping to accommodate the need for greenery and yet not the height that would impede viewing the sign.

G.A.C.C. Concerns:

- Doubtful that Amber Alerts or any other alerts would actually be posted there due to local rules and regulations.
- Potential safety issue.
- Nora Northside Community Council voted against it.
- Further issues with landscaping.
