September 2007 Public Land Use Meeting  
Minutes

Tuesday, September 11, 2007, 7 pm. Epworth United Methodist Church—6450 Allisonville Road.

In attendance were Bob Lehnen, Mike Bivens, Keith Sims and Don Melloy. Also in attendance were Timothy Ochs, attorney for T-Mobile, Steve Carr and Jason Bechtel from T-Mobile and 16 neighbors. (see sign in sheet)

Vice President Lehnen welcomed attendees and asked Mr. Ochs to make his presentation in behalf of T-Mobile. Mr. Ochs explained how the new technology was different from existing cell phone towers. It is an attachment to the top of an existing utility pole, the 2<sup>nd</sup> pole east from Allisonville Road on E. 70<sup>th</sup> Street. This will require the existing 30' pole to be replaced with a 54' pole, including the T-Mobile equipment. There will also be an equipment box, 3' X4' located on the ground by the pole. For references, the existing poles on the west side of Allisonville are 92' high. Mr. Ochs also suggested that we could see a similar installation at 96<sup>th</sup> and Mollenkoff near the Dairy Queen, although, this proposed pole on 70<sup>th</sup> Street will utilize newer technology making it smaller.

Discussion and questions centered around color of equipment box, availability of a shared tower, future upgrades of the structure, locate equipment box on south side of pole, 15' x 30' work area identified on the site plan, and could T-Mobile make a contribution to the Tanglewood neighborhood association.

This petition has not been filed and the board took no action.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned at 8:30, after Mr. Lehnen thanked all for attending.
